- 1 Learn the key anatomical landmarks and structures involved in various nerve blocks, enhancing the ability to accurately identify target areas using ultrasound.

- 4 Develop the ability to quickly and accurately interpret a wide range of ultrasound images, including normal and pathological findings across various organ systems.
